RETAIL BUSINESS HOLIDAYS ACT EXEMPTION

STC is applying for an exemption from the Retail Business Holidays Act, to be permitted to open on the following six Statutory Holidays, like the neighbouring shopping centres, throughout the GTA:

- New Year's Day
- Canada Day
- Labour Day
- Family DayVictoria Day
- Thanksgiving Day
- A CONTRACT OF A

STC is excluded from opening on Statutory Holidays while these surrounding GTA shopping centres are exempt from the Retail Business Holidays Act and are permitted to be open.



SUBSTANTIAL ECONOMIC IMPACT

Currently, STC is not permitted to be open on Statutory Holidays, which has a significant impact on the local economy. On the Statutory Holidays when STC is closed, customers are taking their money out of the local economy and putting it into York Region.
