227,500 more people within walking distance to transit



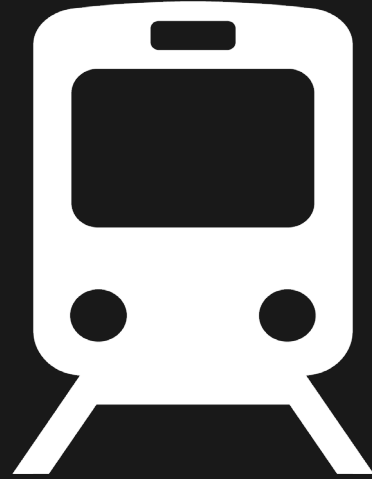
388,000 daily boardings



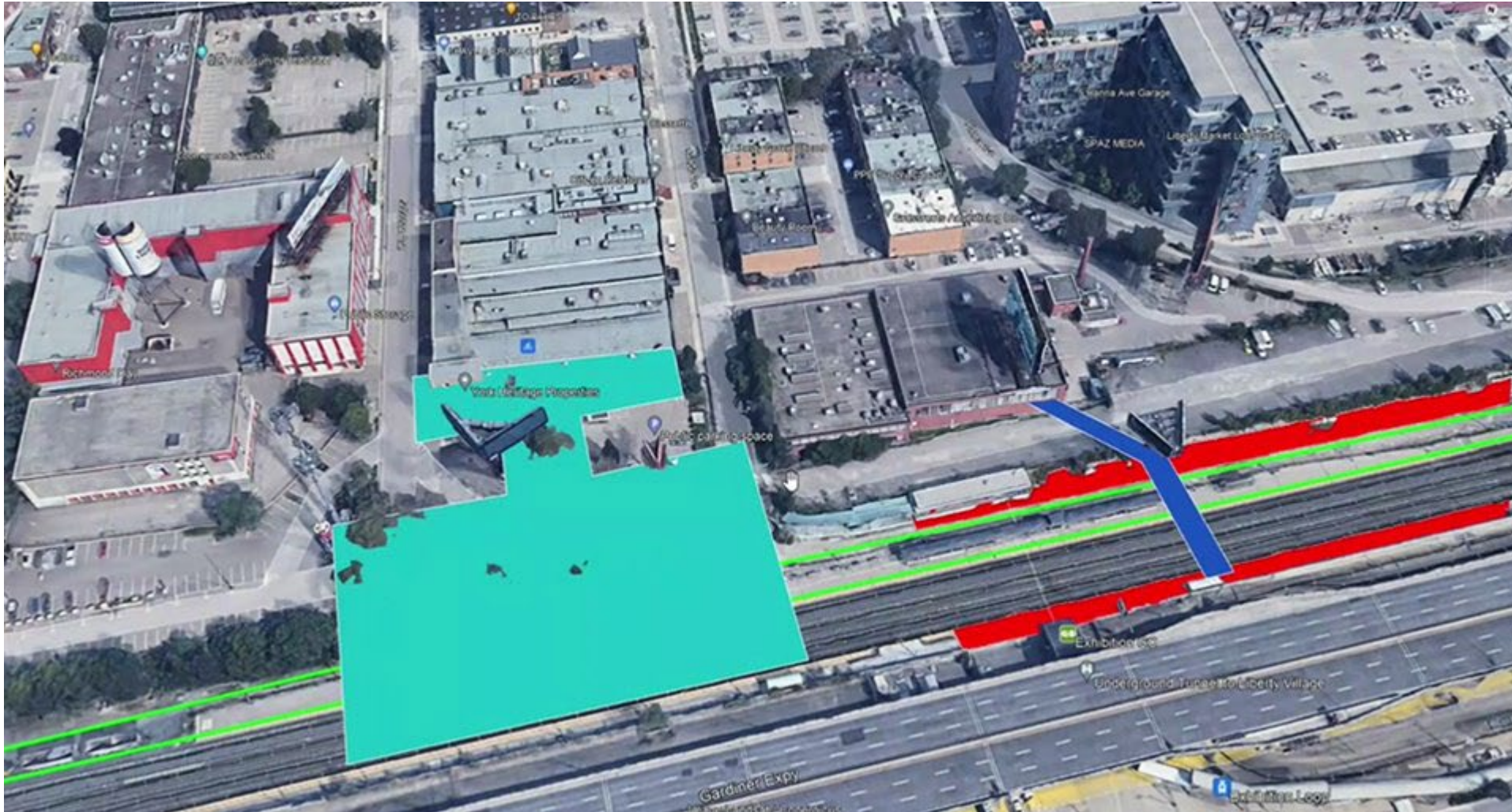
40+ connections to other transit options

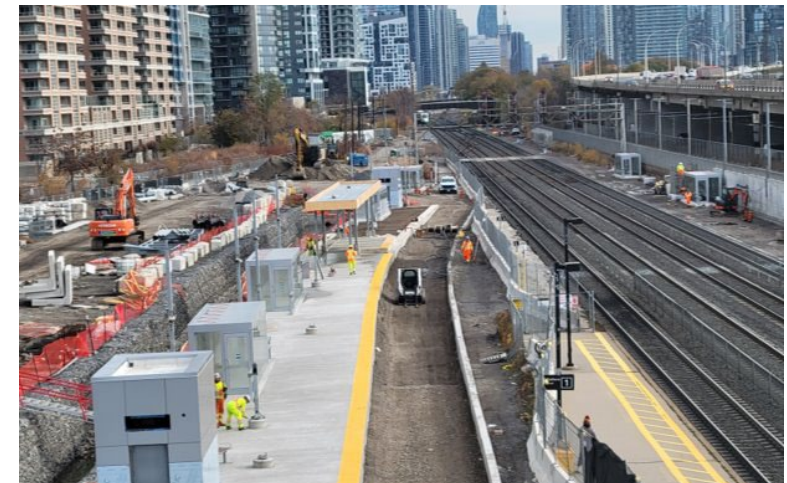

Early Works continues at Exhibition Station in preparation for **first staging and laydown handover to South Civils Project Co.**



EARLY WORKS PROGRESS UPDATE & UPCOMING WORK

- Key Early Works construction updates include ongoing progress on:
 - the existing temporary and new Atlantic Ave. headhouses, utility and sewer relocation, among other preparatory site work.
 - rail track relocation and new north platform opening on **December 04, 2023**.
- Upcoming Early Works includes:
 - the opening of a new station entrance;
 - completion of the temporary pedestrian bridge **by April 2024**;
 - relocating and extending the GO station south platform accommodate a 12-car GO train;
 - removal of the existing north platform; and



OVERALL PROGRESS UPDATE & UPCOMING WORK

- Early Works will be followed by construction of a new concourse by the Ontario Transit Group contractor.
- Planning and design for the Metrolinx Ontario Place Connection project to restart in 2024 in coordination with Exhibition Place's on-going master plan exercise.
