The following is a summary of the terms and conditions of the service agreement between the City of Toronto and Bell Canada regarding the provision of Next Generation 9-1-1 services.

Key Terms

- Next Generation 9-1-1 (NG 9-1-1)
- Public Safety Answering Point (PSAP)
- Tariff Bell Canada has standard general tariffs that contain the most recent rates, charges, terms and conditions applicable to the various services offered by Bell. The applicable Tariffs for this Agreement contain specific operational requirements Bell, the City and its designated PSAPs must follow. The Tariffs also contain potential charges and fees that could be incurred should service requirements or needs change in the future.
