

ATTACHMENT #4 - TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING AND FUNDING AGREEMENT WITH TORONTO ALLIANCE TO END HOMELESSNESS

Proposed Terms and Conditions	
Parties	City of Toronto (City) Toronto Alliance to End Homelessness (TAEH)
Term	From the date of signing until December 31, 2029
Objectives	To advance shared City and TAEH priorities including: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. Identifying land owned by the non-profit sector to create new affordable and supportive housing; b. Supporting the creation of 18,000 supportive homes by 2030, and advancing a high-quality, growing, and sustainable system of supportive housing in Toronto; c. Systems planning and coordination to strengthen the sector, including building the capacity of organizations to develop and operate new supportive housing; d. Supporting intergovernmental advocacy related to non-profit housing, including supportive housing. e. Protecting and supporting the resilience of the existing supply of supportive housing; f. Identifying opportunities to secure and optimize funding for health and social supports; and g. Building connections between housing and health systems, including community health and hospital partners.
Target	Approval of 4,500 new affordable and RGI supportive housing opportunities to be developed by TAEH members.
Roles/Responsibilities and Program Evaluation	The parties will meet to establish an initial partnership and program evaluation framework. The framework may be modified from time to time. Progress on advancing the target noted above will be evaluated on an annual basis.

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City Funding

Subject to a separate detailed funding agreement, on terms and conditions satisfactory to the Executive Director, Housing Secretariat and in a form satisfactory to the City Solicitor, the City will provide up to \$115,000 in funding to TAEH in 2023 to advance the shared objectives noted above.
