NOTICE OF INTENTION TO AMEND ZONING BY-LAW 206-2022 TO REMOVE A HOLDING PROVISION (H)

(Under the Planning Act)

Application to amend Zoning By-law 206-2022 to lift the Holding ("H") provision from the zoning on the subject lands to permit comprehensive multi-phased mixed-use development which includes four buildings and eight towers with over 15,000 square metres of non-residential gross floor area and 2,875 residential units. The 'H' provision was imposed to enable the applicant to provide additional information related to site servicing demonstrating sufficient capacity in the sanitary sewer systems and confirm all required upgrades and improvements have been financially secured. 5415-5481, 5485 and 5487 Dundas Street West and 15 and 25 Shorncliffe Road Ward 3 – Etobicoke Lakeshore
