At its meeting held on February 27, 2023, Etobicoke York Community Council appointed three members to the George Bell Arena Board for a term of office ending June 23,

At its meeting held on May 14, 2019, City Council waived the two-term limit provision of the Public Appointments Policy and appointed three members to the George Bell Arena Board for a term of office ending April 24, 2023, and until successors are appointed.

COMMENTS

Composition of the George Bell Arena Board

The board is composed of:

- The Councillor for Ward 5
- 10 public members
- 1 non-voting staff member from the Parks, Forestry and Recreation Division

There are currently two positions under consideration

There are currently two vacant positions on the board which are under consideration. These positions are the result of the resignation of Cvitan Brkic on March 17, 2023 and a position currently held by a public member whose term ends on April 24, 2023, though members continue to serve until successors are appointed.

Term of office

The term of office for public appointees to the George Bell Arena Board is four years. Members appointed through this current process will serve a term of office ending June 20, 2027, and until successors are appointed.

The City Clerk recruits candidates for Arena Boards and makes recommendations to Community Council

City Council has authorized the City Clerk to screen, interview and recommend candidates for the George Bell Arena Board to the Etobicoke York Community Council.

City Clerk's staff conducted outreach to attract qualified individuals with relevant skills and qualifications. City Clerk's staff promoted the opportunity using social media and volunteer search websites. Consideration was also given to reflecting gender, diversity, and geographical representation on the George Bell Arena Board.

Staff from the City Clerk's Office and Parks, Forestry and Recreation shortlisted and interviewed candidates based on the City Council approved qualifications and eligibility criteria. Parks, Forestry and Recreation staff were asked to participate on the panel as subject matter experts in community recreation programs and services.

The panel consisted of:

- Operation Support Officer, Community Recreation, Parks, Forestry & Recreation
- Acting People Services Consultant, Public Appointments, City Clerk's Office

The panel determined the final candidates by weighing their application and interview performance.

Staff are recommending two highly qualified candidates for appointment

Staff from Parks, Forestry and Recreation and City Clerk's Office are recommending two highly qualified candidates for appointment to the George Bell Arena Board (see Attachment 1). These candidates cover a range of City Council approved qualifications for the George Bell Arena Board with the relevant knowledge and experience to support the board's mandate.
