Outcomes From the Previous Term

- The Toronto Francophone Affairs Advisory Committee (TFAAC)'s previous term was 2019 – 2022
- TFAAC met 8 times over the course of the previous term, roughly two times a year
- TFAAC addressed a range of issues, including:
 - strengthening Toronto's links to the global Francophonie;
 - post-secondary training and entrepreneurship;
 - Francophones in the local labour market;
 - access to City services by Francophones;
 - advocating for the needs of the local Francophone community; and
 - informing the provision of City services.
- Unfortunately, the COVID-19 pandemic did disrupt some of the 2019 – 2022 Work Plan, as outlined in [2022.FA8.4](#) Toronto Francophone Affairs Advisory Committee End of Term Report
