BOH July 4, 2023 – What is Known



- Recap of City of Toronto's financial outlook
 - > Funding required from other orders of government
- 2024 Estimated Cost of Living Adjustment (COLA)
 - > \$5.6 million for salaries and benefits
- Current cost-shared funding model
 - Remains unchanged from proposed plan from the 2019 Provincial Budget
 - > 70 % provincial / 30% municipal since 2019
 - Mitigation funding has keep the funding model at the pre-2019 Provincial Budget levels

- TPH's 2023 Accountability Agreement with the Ministry of Health is outstanding
- Ministry of Health cost-shared model, 2024 and beyond
 - COVID-19 in 2024 and beyond

City of Toronto's 2024 Budget Direction




2023 Operating Budget* by Funder

High


- Funding comes from revenues generated from fees, and/or
- Program funding linked to COVID-19 and renewed on an annual basis

Mid-High

- Funding depends on mitigation funding from the Province,
- Funding provided for a finite timeframe, and/or
- Funding linked to a projects with defined end dates

Mid

- Program costs are higher than funding provided, and/or
- Funding renewed on a year-by-year basis






Risk profile based on TPH's risk management framework

Impact of 2019 Provincial Budget Announcement (in \$ millions)






Impact of 2019 Provincial Budget Announcement (in \$ thousands)

The City has funded all Cost of Living Adjustments (COLA) for cost-shared programs since 2019 at 100%
