I am writing in support of implementing the 8.6 centreline kilometres (km) of new bikeways across the city within the following five projects:

- Bloor Street West: Runnymede Road to Resurrection Road (cycle tracks, Ward 3 and 4)
- Bartlett-Havelock-Gladstone Cycling Connections project (Ward 9)
- Cabbagetown Cycling Connections project (Ward 13)
- Sheppard Avenue: Clairtrell Road to Leslie Avenue (cycle tracks, Ward 17)
- Superior Avenue: Lake Shore Boulevard and Stanley Avenue (cycle tracks, Ward 3), part of the Mimico Neighborhood Mobility project.

If Toronto is going to meet its TransformTO goal of having 75% of all trips under 5 km taken by biking, walking or taking transit by 2030, we need to implement safe cycling and pedestrian infrastructure across the city, especially in areas that lack access to safe active modes of transportation.
