The average small business is still working toward being cash-flow positive after a lengthy covid-recovery. CEBA, if we're to pay that back starting next month, would require over \$5700/month in payments to meet the deadline. We cannot afford that yet. Even though we're on a path to recovery and growth in the last few months is strong, we're early in that process. Covid recovery just began this year, which was not considered at the time CEBA parameters were chosen. We need another year to be able to absorb the payment requirements to get the benefit of CEBA, rather than turning it into another burden.
