Dear Mayor and Councillors,

On behalf of the Leslieville BIA and our BIA Board of Directors we are fully in favour of Councillor Fletcher's motion MM6.1 in support of our small business. Many small business operators in our catchment area are still struggling to recover from COVID. With inflation and a recession looming, business patrons are not spending as much money as they did prepandemic.

Our BIA businesses are additionally impacted by ongoing substantial construction in our area for the Ontario Line. The rapidly advancing repayment deadline of December 2023 for CEBA loans is adding additional strain to our small business operators who are already close to a breaking point.

Many will be forced to take on more debt to meet the December deadline and qualify for the \$20,000 in promised CEBA debt forgiveness. Others not able to pay in time will not only lose out on the \$20,000 in debt relief but also be charged interest on their CEBA loan.

The City needs to have the backs of our BIA's main street businesses. Please support Councillor Paula Fletcher's motion 2023.MM6.1.
