MM8.4 Protecting the Science Centre to Support Thorncliffe and Flemingdon Park - by Councillor Josh Matlow, seconded by Councillor Jon Burnside

Dear Mayor Olivia Chow and Members of Council,

DMRI community strongly opposes the Provincial government's proposed move of the Ontario Science Centre to a much smaller location at Ontario Place. Our area is undergoing rapid changes with unprecedented increase in density along Eglinton, Leslie, Don Mills and York Mills and of course mega developments in Wynford/ Concord and Thorncliffe/ Femingdon areas and on the "Celestica" land. In view of all these developments, a decision made in the absence of consultation with the public, the local community, and the City of Toronto is particularly shocking as it completely disregards needs of the growing community. Complete communities need green spaces, sport facilities, cultural, educational and social spaces which are easily accessible for local community as well as for the entire City (the existing Science Center is locate the Eglinton Crosstown LRT). We cannot afford to loose what exists and is well used by the community

Councillors' motion is calling on the City of Toronto Council to exercise its accountability to all Torontonians by exploring means to keep the Science Centre at its current location. We fully support their motion and hope for more public consultations.
