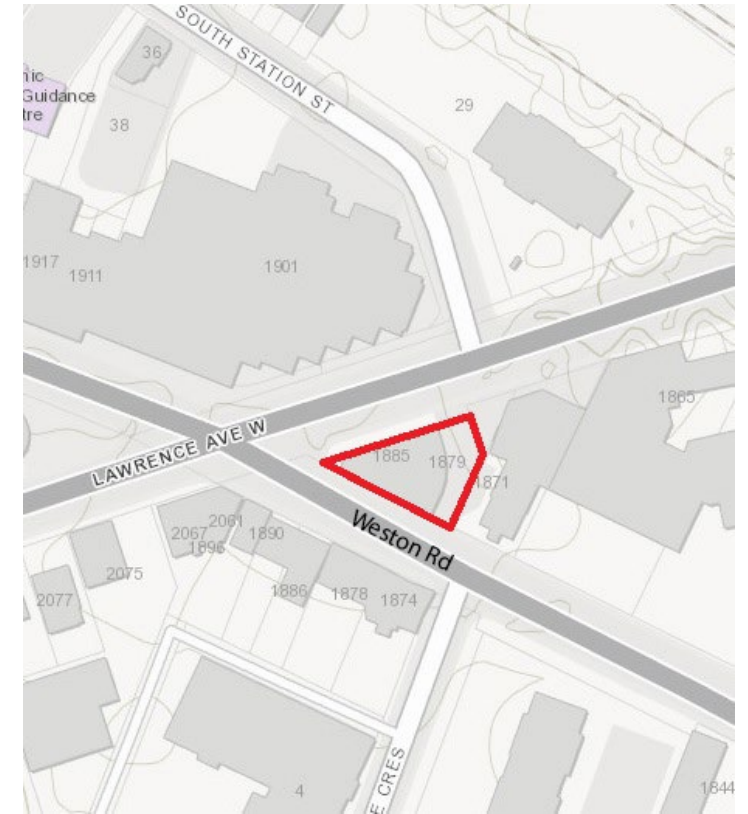

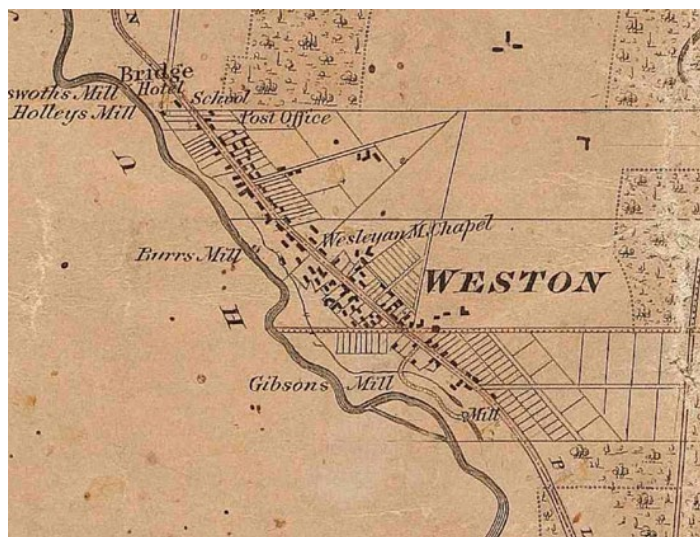

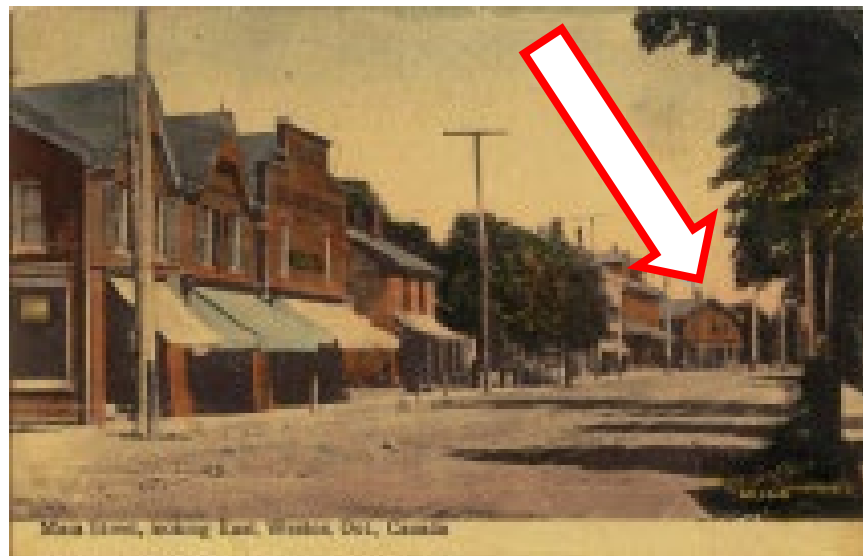

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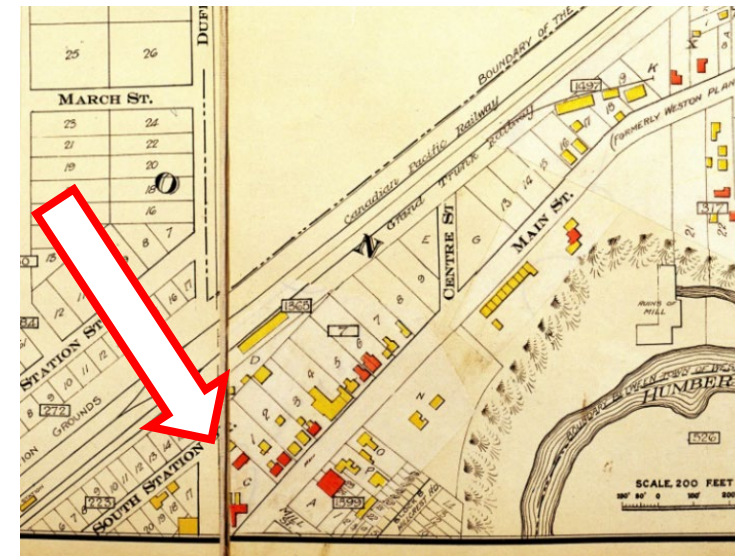

Early 1910s photo of the first Bank of Nova Scotia building at 1879-1885 Weston Rd



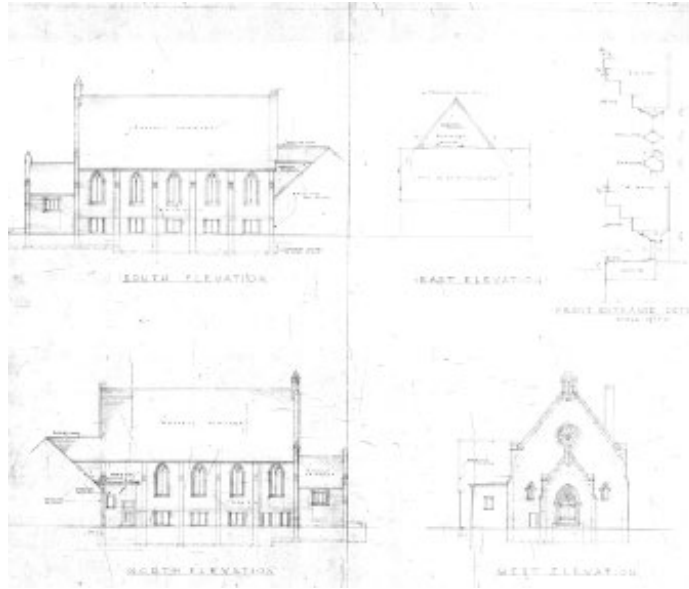

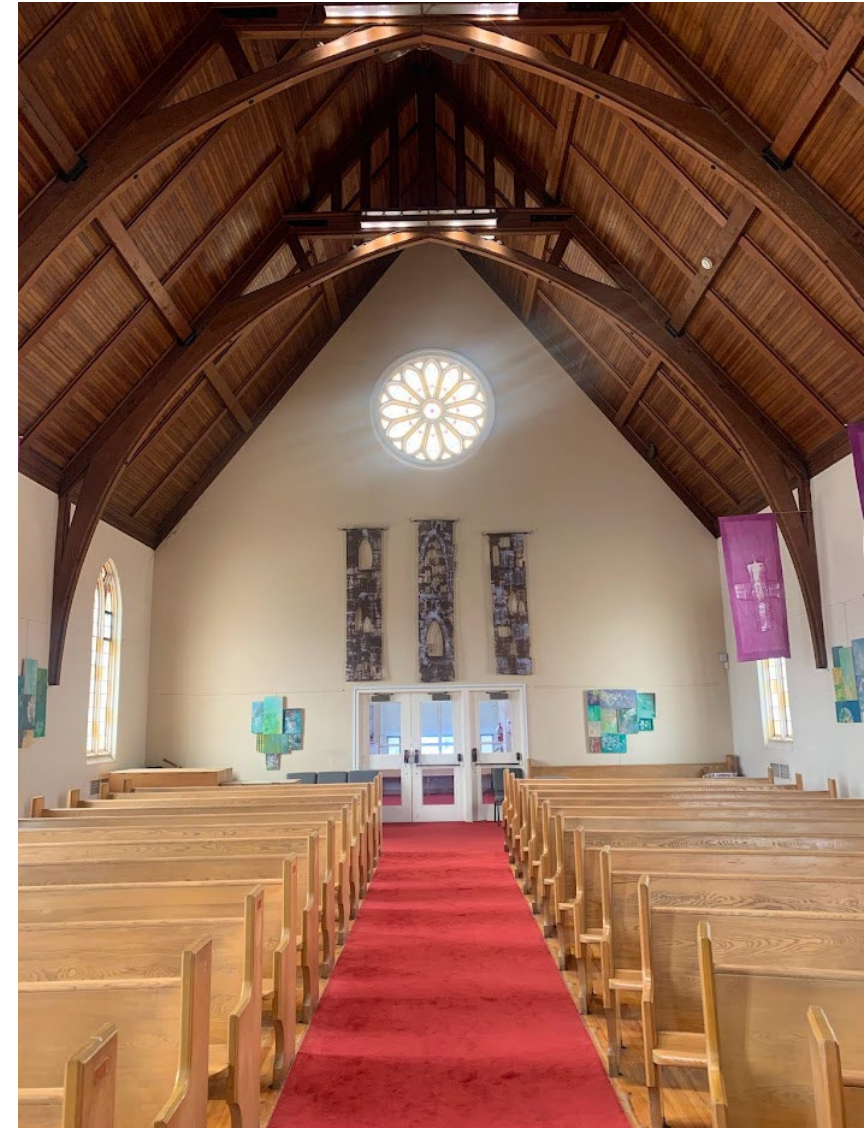
