When Donna wasn't at City Hall, she was often in a yoga studio where she learned to do a head stand in her 40s and ultimately became a licensed yoga instructor in 2013 so she could share her love of the practice with others.

Donna will be greatly missed by her colleagues and friends who knew her for her boundless energy, infectious laughter and big hugs. She will be most deeply missed by her sisters Wanda and Joanna who spent the last year caring for Donna as she underwent cancer treatment.
