MM13.29	Confronting the Legacy of the Transatlantic Slave Trade: Renaming Civic Assets Bearing the Henry Dundas Name - by Councillor Chris Moise, seconded by Mayor Olivia Chow.	<p style="text-align: center;">Jane/Dundas Library</p> <p>Removal of the name Dundas from the Jane/Dundas Library Branch is expected to have minimal costs (approximately \$0.060 million) and can be accommodated as part of the 2024 Operating Budget for the Toronto Public Library.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Public Education Campaign and Strategic Communication Efforts</p> <p>Undertaking a public education campaign and strategic communication efforts to acknowledge the impact of the trans-Atlantic slave trade and slavery in keeping with the International Decade for People of African Descent is estimated to cost \$0.100 million over two years.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Yonge-Dundas Square</p> <p>Costs associated with the changes at YDS are estimated at \$0.300 to \$0.340 million and will be supported by Section 37 Funds from the local ward</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Dundas Subway and Dundas West Subway Stations:</p> <p>Renaming the Dundas subway and Dundas West subway stations are estimated to cost approximately \$2.2 million in gross expenditures with estimated net city costs of \$0.6 million.</p> <p>The TTC Board will work in collaboration with Toronto Metropolitan University, who has committed to fully fund costs associated with Dundas subway station renaming, currently</p>	<p>This motion is recommending the renaming of four civic assets bearing the Henry Dundas name:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Yonge-Dundas Square • Jane/Dundas Library • Dundas Subway Station and Dundas West Subway Station) <p>The motion also recommends a public education campaign and strategic communication efforts to acknowledge the impact of the trans-Atlantic slave trade and slavery.</p> <p>The financial impact to rename these four civic assets and undertake a public education campaign is estimated to be approximately \$2.7 million over two years with net City costs estimated at approximately \$0.7 million.</p> <p>Estimated costs, cash flow timing and available funding and offsets will be confirmed and included for consideration as part of the 2024 budget process</p>
