REASON FOR CONFIDENTIAL INFORMATION

This report is about labour relations or employee negotiations.

SUMMARY

The purpose of this report is to seek Board approval for a bargaining mandate to negotiate the collective agreement with IATSE Local B-173 Housekeeping at the Meridian Arts Centre, which expires on March 31, 2023.

RECOMMENDATIONS

The President and Chief Executive recommends that the Board of Directors of TO Live:

1. Approve the bargaining mandate to negotiate a new collective bargaining agreement with IATSE Local B-173 Housekeeping at the Meridian Arts Centre, as detailed in Confidential Attachment 1.
2. Direct that the confidential information contained in Confidential Attachment 1 remain confidential in its entirety, as it contains labour relations information or employee negotiations.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

There is no financial impact other than those outlined in Confidential Attachment 1.

DECISION HISTORY

At its June 20, 2018, meeting, the Board approved the current collective bargaining agreement with IATSE Local B-173 Housekeeping at the Meridian Arts Centre.
