

Naming of Proposed Private Street for a Development at 6175, 6183 Kingston Road, 1, 2, 4, 5, 7, 10 and 11 Franklin Avenue

SUMMARY

This report recommends that the name "White Tail Crescent" be approved to identify a Proposed Private Street for a development located at 6175, 6183 Kingston Road, 1, 2, 4, 5, 7, 10 and 11 Franklin Avenue.

RECOMMENDATIONS

Engineering and Construction Services recommends that Scarborough Community Council:

1. Approve the name "White Tail Crescent" to identify a Proposed Private Street for a development at 6175, 6183 Kingston Road, 1, 2, 4, 5, 7, 10 and 11 Franklin Avenue shown as PART 1 on Attachment No.1 Sketch No. PS-2023-015
2. Request the applicant to pay the costs, estimated to be \$500.00, for the fabrication and installation of the street names signage; and
3. Request the owner and successors of the subject lands to maintain, at their own expense, the street names signage installed under Recommendations 2 of this report

FINANCIAL IMPACT

There are no financial implications to the City resulting from the adoption of this report. The estimated cost of \$500.00 for the street names signage is to be paid by the applicant.

DECISION HISTORY

This is the first time that this issue is before Community Council.

COMMENTS

An application was received on July 7, 2022, from a developer requesting to name a Proposed Private Street in connection with their development located at 6175, 6183 Kingston Road, 1, 2, 4, 5, 7, 10 and 11 Franklin Avenue as “White Tail Crescent”.

The following background and rationale provided by the applicant:

“White Tail Crescent”

“Scarborough has been extremely attractive for many reasons and our company has developed quite a few projects in this area.

The most common factor amongst these projects was the fact that deer were present and still are present at almost all the projects. Highland Creek and The Rouge Community deserve the acknowledgement of these beautiful and serene creatures.

Surprisingly after researching “Deer” there were a quite few options available. We thought it was only natural to reference the local favourite “White Tail” deer for the private street”.

The proposed name has been circulated for comment and is acceptable to Toronto Police Service, Toronto Fire Services, and Toronto Paramedic Services.

Deputy Mayor Jennifer McKelvie, Ward 25 - Scarborough-Rouge Park, supports this naming.

Community Councils have delegated authority to decide street naming matters which comply with the City of Toronto Street Naming Policy.
