SUMMARY

The purpose of this report is to recommend to City Council the appointment of Council Members to the City-School Boards Advisory Committee.

RECOMMENDATIONS

The City Clerk recommends that:

1. The Striking Committee consider Members' preferences and recommend to City Council the appointment of four Council Members to the City-School Boards Advisory Committee for a term of office until December 31, 2024, and until successors are appointed.

DECISION HISTORY

City Council, at its meeting on October 11 and 12, 2023, established the City-School Boards Advisory Committee for the 2022-2026 term and directed the City Clerk to canvass Members of Council for their interest in appointment to the City-School Boards Advisory Committee.
