Dear Chair and Members,

Re: Traffic Calming – Kenilworth Avenue (west branch) between Queen Street East and the north end of Kenilworth Avenue (west branch)

BACKGROUND:

Residents have reached out to my office with concerns about speeding along Kenilworth Avenue and have requested that traffic calming measures (speed humps) be installed as a method of addressing these concerns.

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that Toronto and East York Community Council:

1. Waive the poling requirement under the City's Traffic Calming Policy and authorize the installation of traffic calming (speed hump) on Kenilworth Avenue (west branch) between Queen Street East and the north end of Kenilworth Avenue (west branch).
2. Direct the City Solicitor to prepare a by-law to alter the roadway to install one speed hump on Kenilworth Avenue (west branch) between Queen Street East and the north end of Kenilworth Avenue (west branch), generally as shown on the attached Drawing No. TC-107, dated November 2022, from the Director, Traffic Management, Transportation Services.
