Dear Chair and Members,

Re: Traffic Calming – Highcroft Road, between Eastwood Road and Wrenson Road

BACKGROUND:

Residents have reached out to my office with concerns about speeding along their street, and have requested that traffic calming measures (speed bumps) be installed as a method of addressing these concerns. My office polled the homes and there was strong support from the residents for making this change.

I am requesting that speed humps be installed on Highcroft Road, between Eastwood Road and Wrenson Road.

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that Toronto and East York Community Council:

1. Waive the polling requirement under the City's Traffic Calming Policy and authorize the installation of traffic calming (speed humps) on Highcroft Road, between Eastwood Road and Wrenson Road.
2. Direct the City Solicitor to prepare a by-law to alter the roadway to install two speed humps on Highcroft Road, between Eastwood Road and Wrenson Road, generally as shown on the attached Drawing No. TC-104, dated November 2022, from the Director, Traffic Management, Transportation Services.
