

Extension of Permit Parking Hours - Alcorn Avenue

SUMMARY

This staff report is about a matter that Community Council has delegated authority from City Council to make a final decision.

Transportation Services is recommending that overnight on-street permit parking hours be extended on Alcorn Avenue, between Yonge Street and Oaklands Avenue, from 12:01 a.m. to 7:00 a.m., 7 days a week to the new hours of 12:01 a.m. to 10:00 a.m. and 5:30 p.m. to 7:30 p.m., 7 days a week.

Residents requested the extension of the overnight on-street permit parking hours on Alcorn Avenue, to improve parking flexibility and to allow the Parking Enforcement Unit, Toronto Police Service, to effectively control long term parking by non-residents through tagging and towing operations.

RECOMMENDATIONS

The Director, Permits and Enforcement, Transportation Services recommends that:

1. Toronto and East York Community Council rescind the existing permit parking provision in effect on Alcorn Avenue 12:01 a.m. to 10:00 a.m. daily on the odd (south) side of Alcorn Avenue , from a point 71 metres west of Yonge Street to Walker Avenue.
2. Toronto and East York Community Council rescind the existing permit parking provision in effect on Alcorn Avenue 12:01 a.m. to 10:00 a.m. daily on the odd (south) side of Alcorn Avenue , from a point 71 metres west of Yonge Street to Oaklands Avenue.
3. Toronto and East York Community Council rescind the existing permit parking provision in effect on Alcorn Avenue 12:01 a.m. to 10:00 a.m. daily on the even (north) side of Alcorn Avenue , Walker Avenue to Oaklands Avenue.

4. Toronto and East York Community Council prohibit parking except by permit 12:01 a.m. to 10:00 a.m. and 5:30 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. daily on the odd (south) side of Alcorn Avenue , from a point 71 metres west of Yonge Street to Walker Avenue.
5. Toronto and East York Community Council prohibit parking except by permit 12:01 a.m. to 10:00 a.m. and 5:30 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. daily on the even (north) side of Alcorn Avenue , from Walker Avenue to Oaklands Avenue.
6. Toronto and East York Community Council rescind the existing parking prohibition in effect at all times on the north side of Alcorn Avenue, from a point 103 metres west of Yonge Street and a point 15 metres east of Oaklands Avenue.
7. Toronto and East York Community Council prohibit parking at all times on the north side of Alcorn Avenue, from a point 103 metres west of Yonge Street to Walker Avenue.
8. Toronto and East York Community Council rescind the existing maximum one-hour parking regulation in effect from 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 a.m., daily, on the north side of Alcorn Avenue between Walker Avenue and a point 15 metres east of Oaklands Avenue.
9. Toronto and East York Community Council authorize parking for a maximum of one-hour from 10:00 a.m. to 5:30 a.m., daily, on the north side of Alcorn Avenue between Walker Avenue and a point 15 metres east of Oaklands Avenue.
10. Toronto and East York Community Council rescind the existing maximum one-hour parking regulation in effect from 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 a.m., daily, on the south side of Alcorn Avenue from a point 71 metres west of Yonge Street to Walker Avenue.
11. Toronto and East York Community Council authorize parking for a maximum of one-hour from 10:00 a.m. to 5:30 a.m., daily, on the south side of Alcorn Avenue from a point 71 metres west of Yonge Street to Walker Avenue.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

All costs associated with the necessary signage changes are available within the Transportation Services interim 2023 Operating Budget.

DECISION HISTORY

This report addresses a new initiative.

COMMENTS

A request was received from the Ward Councillor, on behalf of area residents, to extend the overnight on-street permit parking hours on Alcorn Avenue, between Yonge Street and Oaklands Avenue.

Existing Conditions

Alcorn Avenue is characterized by the following conditions:

- It is a local roadway, operating two-way on a pavement width of approximately 6.5 metres
- Posted speed 30 km/h
- There are sidewalks located on both sides of the street
- There is no TTC service

The parking regulations on Alcorn Avenue are as follows:

Even/North Side

- No parking, anytime, 103 metres west of Yonge Street and a point 15 metres east of Oaklands Avenue
- No stopping, anytime, Yonge Street and a point 103 metres west
- Restricted parking, one hour maximum, 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., between Walker Avenue and a point 15 metres east of Oaklands Avenue

Odd/South Side

- No parking, anytime, Walker Avenue and Oaklands Avenue
- No standing, anytime, from Yonge Street and a point 71 metres west
- Restricted parking, one hour maximum, 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., from a point 71 metres west of Yonge Street and Walker Avenue

A map of the area is included in Attachment 1.

Transportation Services has no objections to the extension of permit parking hours, and adjustment of restricted parking hours, on Alcorn Avenue, between Yonge Street and Oaklands Avenue.

The Ward Councillor has been advised of the recommendation in this report.

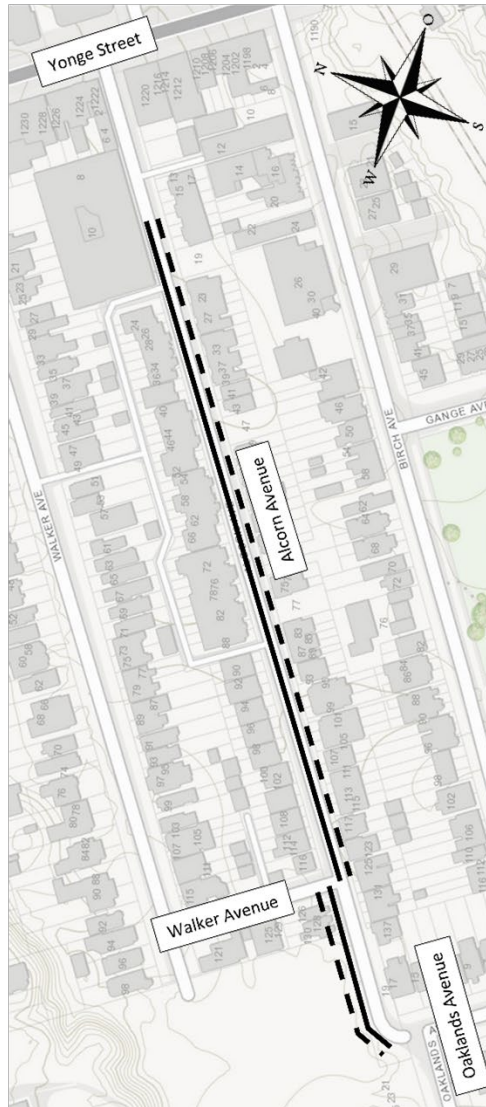
