

Parking Amendments - Wolverleigh Boulevard

SUMMARY

This staff report is about a matter that Community Council has delegated authority to make a final decision.

Transportation Services is recommending the approval of parking for a maximum period of one-hour, in effect from 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday to Friday, on both sides of Wolverleigh Boulevard, between Monarch Park Avenue and Coxwell Avenue. The proposed amendment will discourage long-term daytime parking, and increase parking turnover on this section of Wolverleigh Avenue.

RECOMMENDATIONS

The Director, Traffic Management, Transportation Services recommends that:

1. Toronto and East York Community Council authorise parking for a maximum period of one hour, from 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday to Friday, from the first day to the 15th day of each month from April 1 to November 30, inclusive, on the north side of Wolverleigh Boulevard, between Monarch Park Avenue and Coxwell Avenue.
2. Toronto and East York Community Council authorise parking for a maximum period of one hour, from 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday to Friday, from the 16th day to the last day of each month from April 1 to November 30, inclusive, on the south side of Wolverleigh Boulevard, between Monarch Park Avenue and Coxwell Avenue.
3. Toronto and East York Community Council authorise parking for a maximum period of one-hour, from 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday to Friday, from December 1 of one year to March 31 of the next following year, inclusive, on the south side of Wolverleigh Boulevard, between Monarch Park Avenue and Coxwell Avenue.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

The signage costs associated with the proposed amendments are approximately \$2,800.00. Funding is available within the Transportation Services 2023 Interim Operating Budget.

DECISION HISTORY

This report addresses a new initiative.

COMMENTS

The Ward Councillor forwarded a petition from residents of Wolverleigh Boulevard, requesting that parking be limited to a maximum period of one hour, from 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday to Friday, on Wolverleigh Boulevard, between Monarch Park Avenue and Coxwell Avenue. The requested changes are intended to discourage long-term parking and promote parking turnover on this section of Wolverleigh Boulevard.

Existing Conditions

Wolverleigh Boulevard, between Monarch Park Avenue and Coxwell Avenue, is characterized by the following conditions:

- It is a two-lane, east-west, local roadway
- It operates two-way traffic on a pavement width of approximately 8.4 metres
- The speed limit is 30 km/h
- Heavy trucks are prohibited at all times
- There is no Toronto and Transit Commission (TTC) service provided
- There are sidewalks provided on both sides of the street

The surrounding land use consists of single-family residential dwellings.

The parking regulations on Wolverleigh Boulevard, between Monarch Park Avenue and Coxwell Avenue, are as follows:

North side

- No parking anytime from December 1 of one year to March 31 of the next following year, inclusive
- No parking anytime from the 16th day to the last day of each month, inclusive, from April 1 to November 30
- No parking except by permit from 12:01 a.m. to 10:00 a.m., in effect at all times, from 1st day to the 15th day of each month, inclusive, from April 1 to November 30, inclusive

South side

- No parking anytime from 1st day to the 15th day of each month, inclusive, from April 1 to November 30, inclusive
- No parking except by permit from 12:01 a.m. to 10:00 a.m., in effect at all times, from 16th day to the last day of each month, inclusive, from April 1 to November 30, inclusive, and from December 1 of one year to March 31 of the next following year, inclusive

Proposed Changes

In an effort to improve the current parking arrangements on Wolverleigh Boulevard, residents have submitted a petition to the Ward Councillor's office, requesting that parking be limited to a maximum period of one hour, from 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday to Friday, on Wolverleigh Boulevard. Between 6:00 p.m. and 12:01 a.m., parking is permitted for a maximum period of three hours. The proposed parking for a maximum period of one hour will discourage long-term parking, and increase parking turnover on this section of Wolverleigh Boulevard.

On-street permit parking holders will be exempted from the one-hour parking limit regulation. The maximum one-hour parking limit will impact residents' visitors, including guests, caretakers, service people, etc. As the residents have been advised of the impacts, Transportation Services has no objections to a maximum one-hour parking limit from 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday to Friday, on Wolverleigh Boulevard, between Monarch Park Avenue and Coxwell Avenue.

A map of the area and proposed parking amendment is included in Attachment 1.
