

Application for Fence Exemption – 219 Quebec Avenue

SUMMARY

This staff report concerns a matter for which the Toronto & East York Community Council has delegated authority from City Council to make a final decision.

The purpose of this report is to consider an application by the owner(s) of 219 Quebec Avenue to maintain an electric roller door fence with a wooden frame. The fence has a height of 2.7 meters (9 feet) in the side yard on the north side of the property. The fence has a width of approximately 3.6 meters (12 feet) and is abutting 223 Quebec Avenue. The fence is for security and privacy. It resembles a garage door. The fence would be in contravention of the Toronto Municipal Code, Chapter 447-1.2B (1) Table 1 – Maximum Height of Fences. Based on a complaint, a Notice of Violation was issued on April 27, 2021.

RECOMMENDATIONS

Municipal Licensing & Standards recommends that the Toronto & East York Community Council:

1. Refuse to grant the application for an exemption permit, by the owner(s) of 219 Quebec Avenue to maintain an electric roller door fence with a height of 2.7 meters (9 feet) in the side yard on the north side of the property, which does not comply with the Toronto Municipal Code, Chapter 447, Fences, specifically section 447-1.2B (1) Table 1- Maximum Height of Fences.

OR

2. Grant the application for an exemption permit, by the owner(s) of 219 Quebec Avenue to maintain an electric roller door fence with a height of 2.7 meters (9 feet) in the side yard on the north side of the property. Direct and require that the existing fence be maintained in good repair without alteration. Direct and require that at

such time as a replacement of the fence is required that such installation will comply with Municipal Code Chapter 447-Fences, or its successor by-law.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

There is no financial impact anticipated in this report.

DECISION HISTORY

As required by Section 447-1.5(B)(1), Municipal Licensing & Standards has responded to the fence exemption application by preparing this report for Toronto & East York Community Council's consideration, and, the City Clerk has sent all requisite notifications of the date that Toronto & East York Community Council will consider the application.

COMMENTS

The proposed fence violates Toronto Municipal Code, Chapter 447 – Fences requirements with respect to fence height.
