Dear Chair and Members,

Re: Re-opening and Technical Amendment Item TE2.42 - Accessible Parking Spaces - January 2023 (Delegated)

This item is about a matter that Community Council has delegated authority to make a final decision, provided that it is not amended.

This change will improve accessibility for residents who require these spaces.

The proposed revision to the accessible parking spaces on the west and east sides of Bartlett Avenue and on the west side of Westmount Avenue are to be replaced with the recommendations below.

RECOMMENDATIONS

1. Toronto and East York Community Council reopen Item TE2.42, headed "Accessible Parking Spaces - January 2023 (Delegated)", from the Director, Traffic Management, Transportation Services, pertaining only to the accessible parking spaces on the west and east sides of Bartlett Avenue and on the west side of Westmount Avenue, for further consideration.
2. Toronto and East York Community Council delete the entries in Attachment 1: On-street Accessible Parking Spaces to be Installed/Removed at the locations identified in Table 1 to the report (January 10, 2023) from the Director, Traffic Management, Transportation Services, pertaining only to the accessible parking spaces on the west and east sides of Bartlett Avenue and on the west side of Westmount Avenue, and replace them with the following:

On-street accessible parking spaces to be installed:

Ward 9 Location

Bartlett Avenue, east side, between a point 70.3 metres south of Craftsman Lane and a point 5.5 metres further south.

Westmount Avenue, west side, between a point 51.7 metres south of Cloverlawn Avenue and a point 5.5 metres further south.
