Re: Reopening the Accessible Parking Space installation on Shaw Street

At its meeting on February 23, 2023, Toronto and East York Community Council approved the implementation of an accessible parking space on Shaw Street. The Community Council decision can be found at:

Transportation Services is requesting that this item be re-opened in order to adjust an incorrect entry pertaining to this location.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

It is recommended that:

1. Toronto and East York Community Council reopen Item TE3.18, headed "Accessible Parking Spaces - February 2023 (Delegated)", from the Director, Traffic Management, Transportation Services, pertaining only to the accessible parking spaces on the west side of Shaw Street , for further consideration.
2. Toronto and East York Community Council delete the entry in Attachment 1: On-street Accessible Parking Spaces to be Installed/Removed, attached to the report (January 10, 2023) from the Director, Traffic Management, Transportation Services, pertaining only to the accessible parking space the west side of Shaw Street, and replace it with the following:
