Re: Traffic Calming – Wolverleigh Boulevard, between Glebemount Avenue and Woodbine Avenue

To the Chair and Members of Toronto and East York Community Council:

BACKGROUND:

Residents have reached out to my office with concerns about road safety and speeding along Wolverleigh Blvd. My office polled local residents and the majority were in favour. In order to make our community safer for all, I recommend installing speed humps on this street.

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that:

1. Toronto and East York Community Council waive the polling requirement under the City's Traffic Calming Policy and authorize the installation of traffic calming (speed humps) on Wolverleigh Boulevard, between Glebemount Avenue and Woodbine Avenue.
2. Toronto and East York Community Council direct the City Solicitor to prepare a by-law to alter the roadway to install three speed humps on Wolverleigh Boulevard, between Glebemount Avenue and Woodbine Avenue, generally as shown on the attached Drawing No. 421G-3902, dated August 2021 from the Director, Traffic Management, Transportation Services.
