## Use of Nathan Phillips Square for Various Events - September 1, 2023 - April 30, 2024

#### **SUMMARY**

The purpose of this report is to request exemptions from the Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 636 "Public Squares" and former City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 237 "Nathan Phillips Square" for events that are proposed to be held on Nathan Phillips Square from September 1, 2023 - April 30, 2024.

#### **RECOMMENDATIONS**

General Manager, Economic Development and Culture recommends that:

- 1. City Council grant permission to the Canadian Association of Chinese Performing Arts (CACPA), Toronto Vegetarian Association/VegTO, Second Harvest Canada, Mexican Day Toronto, City Cultural Events Production, City of Toronto, Canadian Cancer Society, JDRF, Canadian Running Series, Myeloma Canada, Maple Leaf Sports and Entertainment Foundation, The Ontario Snow Resorts Association, Celebrate Toronto, to operate a beer and wine (VQA) garden and to serve alcohol contingent upon the following conditions:
  - Approval of the A.G.C.O.
  - Approval of the Medical Officer of Health
  - Compliance with the City of Toronto's Municipal Alcohol Policy
  - Receipt of all the necessary permits associated with the production of the event i.e. building permits, noise by-law extension permit
- 2. - 8. City Council grant permission to City Cultural Events, City of Toronto, to cover City Hall windows and buildings.
- 9. City Council grant permission to Myeloma Canada to rappel from the east/west towers.
- 10. City Council require that the various events compensate the City of Toronto, through the Corporate Real Estate Management Division, for all the City of Toronto costs associated with an event above the standard staffing compliment.

#### FINANCIAL IMPACT

There are no current or known future year financial impacts arising from the recommendations contained in this report.

The City will be compensated by the event organizers for any costs incurred by the City as a result of these various events and the approval of requested exemptions to Chapter 636 and former City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 237 through the Corporate Real Estate Management Division.

The Chief Financial Officer and Treasurer has reviewed this report and agrees with the information as presented in the Financial Impact Section.

#### **COMMENTS**

The Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 636 "Public Squares" and former City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 237 "Nathan Phillips Square" prohibit the solicitation of donations, the sale of alcohol, placing objects in the reflecting pool, use of open flame and special effects pyrotechnics, amplification of sound outside of Nathan Phillips Square amplification schedule policy, "gated or ticketed" events and engagement in sports demonstrations, and covering of City Hall windows and building on Nathan Phillips Square without the approval of Council.

Various event organizers are requesting permission to solicit donations, engage in sports demonstrations, amplify sound outside of NPS amplification schedule policy, use open flame as part of their event production, operate a beer and wine (VQA) garden, serve alcohol, place objects in the pool, use special effects pyrotechnics and for permission to cover City Hall windows and building. The proceeds of these and other sales will go to their respective non-profit organizations.
