

Accessible Parking Spaces - September 2023 (Delegated)

SUMMARY

This staff report is about a matter that Community Council has delegated authority from City Council to make a final decision.

Transportation Services is requesting approval for the installation/removal of on-street accessible parking spaces for persons with disabilities.

RECOMMENDATIONS

The Director, Traffic Management, Transportation Services recommends that:

1. Toronto and East York Community Council authorize the installation/removal of on-street accessible parking spaces at the locations identified in Attachment 1 and attached to the report entitled "Accessible Parking Spaces-September 2023 (Delegated)", dated August 30, 2023 from the Director, Traffic Management, Transportation Services.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

The signage costs associated with the proposed installation/removal of accessible parking spaces is approximately \$9,700.00. Funding is available within the Transportation Services 2023 Operating Budget.

DECISION HISTORY

This report addresses a new initiative.

COMMENTS

Transportation Services provides designated on-street accessible parking as a convenience for people with disabilities and/or those who transport them, making it easier for them to find available parking as near as possible to their places of residence or intended destinations and reducing the distances that the disabled people must walk.

Designated on-street accessible parking spaces are not for the exclusive use of any one resident. Any person with a valid Accessible Parking Permit issued by the Ministry of Transportation of Ontario (MTO) may park in any designated on-street accessible parking space. Designated on-street accessible parking spaces may be relocated for technical or operational reasons, if deemed necessary by the City.

Delays in installing on-street accessible parking spaces may create hardships for the applicants. Timely removal of a designated on-street accessible parking space when it is no longer needed, for instance when the resident moves or is no longer eligible, aids in maximizing available on-street parking for other residents/motorists.

To be eligible for on-street accessible parking, applicants must hold a valid Accessible Parking Permit, issued by the MTO. Staff have determined that the installation/removal of on-street accessible parking spaces as listed in Attachment 1 is feasible as the requirements are met and each designated space will not result in the loss of more than one on-street parking space for general use.

The Ward Councillors have been advised of the recommendation in this report.

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Table 1: On-street Accessible Parking Spaces to be Installed

Ward	Location
9	Ashburnham Road, south side, between a point 23.1 metres west of McFarland Avenue and a point 5.5 metres further west.
14	Boothroyd Avenue, west side, between a point 74 metres north of Boulton Avenue and a point 5.5 metres further north.
14	Fernwood Park Avenue, west side, between a point 43 metres south of Hazel Avenue and a point 5.5 metres further south.
14	Bloomfield Avenue, north side, between a point 58 metres east of Prust Avenue and a point 5.5 metres further east, from the 1st day to the 15th day of each month, anytime, from April 1 to November 30, inclusive.
14	Bloomfield Avenue, south side, between a point 60 metres east of Prust Avenue and a point 5.5 metres further east, anytime, from the 16th day to the last day of each month from April 1 to November 30, inclusive, and from December 1 of one year to March 31 of the next following year, inclusive.
14	Mountalan Avenue, south side, between a point 54 metres east of Greenwood Avenue and a point 5.5 metres further east.
14	Gillard Avenue, east side, between a point 13 metres north of Felstead Avenue and a point 5.5 metres further north, anytime, from the 1st day to the 15th day of each month from April 1 to November 30, inclusive, and from December 1 of one year to March 31 of the next following year, inclusive.
14	Gillard Avenue, west side, between a point 17.5 metres north of Felstead Avenue and a point 5.5 metres further north, anytime, from the 16th to the last day of each month, from April 1 to November 30, inclusive.
19	Keystone Avenue, north side, between a point 75.5 metres east of Cedarvale Avenue and a point 5.5 metres further east.

19	Milverton Boulevard, north side, between a point 102 metres east of Woodington Avenue and a point 5.5 metres further east, anytime, from the 1st day to the 15th day of each month from April 1 to November 30, inclusive.
19	Milverton Boulevard, south side, between a point 100 metres east of Woodington Avenue and a point 5.5 metres further east, anytime, from the 16th to the last day of each month, from April 1 to November 30, inclusive, and from December 1 of one year to March 31 of the next following year, inclusive.

Ward	Location
9	Hallam Street, north side, between a point 17 metres west of Gladstone Avenue and a point 5.5 metres further west.
9	Nairn Avenue, east side, between a point 20 metres south of Ascot Avenue and a point 5.5 metres further south, from the first day to the 15th day of each month, from Apr. 1 to Nov. 30, inclusive.
9	Nairn Avenue, west side, between a point 20 metres south of Ascot Avenue and a point 5.5 metres further south, from the 16th day to the last day of each month, from Apr. 1 to Nov. 30, inclusive.
9	Russett Avenue, west side, between a point 132.8 metres north of Bloor Street West and a point 5.5 metres further north.
11	Palmerston Avenue, west side, between a point 14 metres north of Vermont Avenue and a point 5.5 metres further north.
13	Ontario Street, west side, between a point 147 metres north of Dundas Street East and a point 5.5 metres further north.
14	Boothroyd Avenue, west side, between a point 69 metres north of Boulton Avenue and a point 5.5 metres further north.
19	Kendal Avenue, east side, between a point 44 metres north of the east-west leg of Kendal Avenue and a point 5.5 metres further north.

19	Waverley Road, east side, between a point 134.5 metres south of Norway Avenue and a point 5.5 metres further south.
19	Roseheath Avenue, east side, between a point 18 metres north of Copeland Avenue West and a point 5.5 metres further north.
19	Gledhill Avenue, west side, between a point 36.5 metres north of Burrell Avenue and a point 5.5 metres further north, during the months of May, July, Sept and Nov.
19	Gledhill Avenue, east side, between a point 25 metres south of Lumsden Avenue and a point 5.5 metres further south, during the months of Jan., Feb., Mar., Apr., June, Aug., Oct. and Dec.
