**Re: Traffic Calming – Cedarvale Avenue between Lumsden Avenue and
Cosburn Avenue**

BACKGROUND:

Residents have reached out to my office with concerns about road safety and speeding along Cedarvale Ave, between Lumsden Avenue and Cosburn Avenue. My office polled local residents and the majority were in favour. In order to make the community safer for all, I recommend installing speed humps on this street.

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that:

1. Toronto and East York Community Council waive the polling requirement under the City's Traffic Calming Policy and authorize the installation of traffic calming (speed humps) on Cedarvale Avenue between Lumsden Avenue and Cosburn Avenue.
2. Toronto and East York Community Council direct the City Solicitor to prepare a by-law to alter the roadway to install five speed humps on Cedarvale Avenue between Lumsden Avenue and Cosburn Avenue, generally as shown on the attached Drawing No. TC-147, dated June 2023 from the Director, Traffic Management, Transportation Services.
