

Attachment 1: List of Traffic Calming Suggestions from Local Residents on Mortimer Avenue

A safer Mortimer Ave means a safer neighbourhood for all of us

A summary of ideas submitted by residents of Mortimer Avenue:

1. A total of **four speed cameras permanently installed** between Broadview and Pape, between Broadview & Logan and between Logan & Pape in each direction
2. A total of **two red light cameras**: one at Broadview Ave and Pottery Rd, the second one at Logan Ave and Mortimer Ave
3. **Reduced speed limits of 30 kph posted** (and a dividing yellow line or mid-road bollards if possible)
4. **A bike lane installed on the south side of Mortimer**
5. **Wider sidewalks** at the corners of the **intersections of Mortimer at Broadview, Jackman, Arundel, Logan, and Carlaw** to increase pedestrian safety
6. **Brighter lighting** that is **more directed at the roadway** so that it feels like a well-lit city street rather than like a highway
7. **Restrictions on turning left at Jackman and Arundel** during peak hours
8. **All-way stops at Burley and Carlaw** to discourage racing straight through between Broadview and Pape
9. Reprogramming **the light at Logan** so that it **rests at red while traveling east/west during off-peak hours**
10. **Advance left turn light at Broadview** to reduce traffic back-up at the lights *Note: this was included in our ideas during the petition signing period up until this point. According to Councillor Fletcher's Aug 24th email, a study done by the city has found that this is not feasible. An alternative solution I propose is disallowing through traffic from Pottery Road onto Mortimer and vice versa to take some of the load off of Mortimer. Traffic in both directions would have to use Broadview Ave to divert either north to the wider roadway of Cosburn Ave or south to our area's major arterial roadway, Danforth Ave.*
11. Designate our section of Mortimer as a **Community Safety Zone, with increased fines** and signs indicating that this is a **traffic calming area**
12. **Increased police presence** to ensure compliance
