Dear Chair and Members,

Re: Traffic Calming – Amroth Avenue, between Danforth Avenue and Oakcrest Avenue

BACKGROUND:

Residents have reached out to my office with concerns about road safety and speeding along Amroth Avenue, between Danforth Avenue and Oakcrest Avenue. As the majority of residents are in favour of this safety initiative, I would like to recommend the installation of speed humps.

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that:

1. Toronto and East York Community Council waive the polling requirement under the City's Traffic Calming Policy and authorize the installation of traffic calming (speed humps) on Amroth Avenue, between Danforth Avenue and Oakcrest Avenue.
2. Toronto and East York Community Council direct the City Solicitor to prepare a by-law to alter the roadway to install four speed humps on Amroth Avenue, between Danforth Avenue and Oakcrest Avenue., generally as shown on the attached Drawing No. TC-165, dated October 2023 from the Director, Traffic Management, Transportation Services.
