Traffic Calming – Aldwych Avenue, between Pape Avenue and Woodycrest Avenue

Dear Chair and members of Toronto and East York Community Council,

Aldwych Avenue is an east-west residential street in East York. I have heard from local residents concerned about speeding on their street, requesting that speed humps be installed. After polling residents of Aldwych Avenue, 77% of residents support the installation of speed humps. This letter includes recommendations to improve safety on the street by installing speed humps.

RECOMMENDATION:

1. Toronto and East York Community Council waive the polling requirement under the City's Traffic Calming Policy and authorize the installation of traffic calming (speed humps) on Aldwych Avenue, between Pape Avenue and Woodycrest Avenue.
2. Toronto and East York Community Council direct the City Solicitor to prepare a by-law to alter the roadway to install three speed humps on Aldwych Avenue, between Pape Avenue and Woodycrest Avenue., generally as shown on the attached Drawing No. TC-164, dated October 2023 from the Director, Traffic Management, Transportation Services.
