

## **Introduction of Overnight On-Street Permit Parking - Area 9C MacLean Avenue**

### **SUMMARY**

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This staff report is about a matter that Community Council has delegated authority from City Council to make a final decision.

Transportation Services is recommending that overnight on-street permit parking be introduced on Maclean Avenue between Pine Crescent and Queen Street East from 12:01 a.m. to 7:00 a.m., daily.

Residents requested the implementation of overnight on-street permit parking on Maclean Avenue between Pine Crescent and Queen Street East to accommodate their long-term parking needs.

### **RECOMMENDATIONS**

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The Director, Permits and Enforcement, Transportation Services recommends that:

1. Toronto and East York Community Council authorize parking by permit only on an area name basis, from 12:01 a.m. to 7:00 a.m. daily on Maclean Avenue between Pine Crescent and Queen Street East, within Area 9C.

### **FINANCIAL IMPACT**

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The estimated funding to implement permit parking is \$400 which is available within Transportation Services 2023 Operating Budget. The maximum annual revenue that could potentially be generated if all parking spaces are occupied by a permit holder is \$7,803.

## DECISION HISTORY

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This report addresses a new initiative.

## COMMENTS

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A request was received from the Ward Councillor, on behalf of area residents, to introduce the overnight on-street permit parking program, on Maclean Avenue between Pine Crescent and Queen Street East to accommodate their long-term parking needs without being subject to tagging by Toronto Police Service, Parking Enforcement Unit.

### Existing Conditions

Maclean Avenue is characterized by the following conditions:

- It is a two-lane, north-south local roadway
- It operates two-way traffic on a pavement width of approximately 7.5 metres
- There is a sidewalk on the north side
- There is no TTC service.

The parking regulations on Maclean Avenue, within the subject section are as follows:

#### West Side

- No parking, Anytime

#### East Side

- No parking except by permit, 12:01 a.m. to 7:00 a.m.

### Polling Results

In accordance with Municipal Code Chapter 925 a poll was conducted to determine if there is support for the installation of overnight on-street permit parking. Ballots were mailed out on August 10, 2023 to all residents on Maclean Avenue between Pine Crescent and Queen Street East with the last day for filing a response being September 8, 2023.

A poll will be considered valid when at least 25 percent of the ballots mailed have been returned to the City Clerk. For Maclean Avenue, 66 ballots were returned which represents a response rate of 57 percent. In order for a poll to be deemed positive, 50 percent plus one of returned ballots must be in favour of the request.

Table 1 summarizes the level of support for the installation of overnight on-street permit parking.

Table 1: Poll Results - Support for Permit Parking - Area 9C MacLean Avenue

| Response Type  | Number of ballots | Percentage |
|----------------|-------------------|------------|
| In Favour      | 50                | 76%        |
| Opposed        | 16                | 24%        |
| Spoiled Ballot | 0                 | 0%         |

As the majority of the ballots returned were in favour of implementing permit parking, and the required minimum response rate was met, the poll was deemed to be positive.

The Ward Councillor has been advised of the recommendation in this report.

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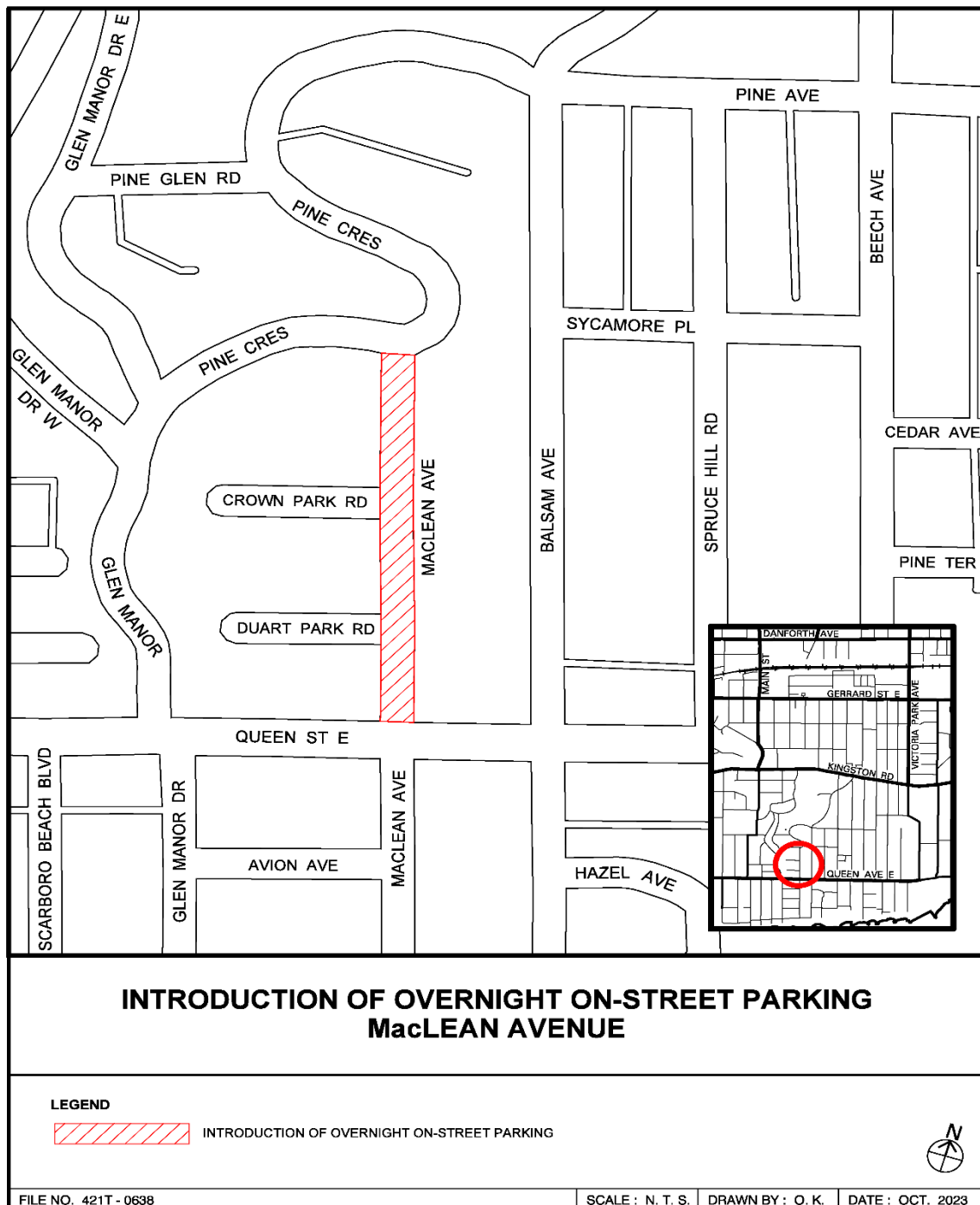
