Dear Chair and Council Members,

Re: Speed Humps on Richmond Street West

While known in the downtown core as a major travel route, Richmond Street West starts at Niagara Street as a residential road, primarily consisting of single family homes and row-houses. Residents have reached out to my office with concerns about road safety and speeding along the street, between Niagara Street and Tecumseth Street. My office polled local residents and the majority were in favour. In order to make the community safer for all, I recommend installing speed humps on this portion of the street.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

It is recommended that:

1. Toronto and East York Community Council waive the polling requirement under the City's Traffic Calming Policy and authorized the installation of traffic calming (speed humps) on Richmond Street West, between Niagara Street and Tecumseth Street.
2. Toronto and East York Community Council direct the City Solicitor to prepare a by-law to alter the roadway to install four speed humps on Richmond Street West, between Niagara Street and Tecumseth Street, generally as shown on the attached Drawing No. TC-188, dated October 2023 from the Director, Traffic Management, Transportation Services.
