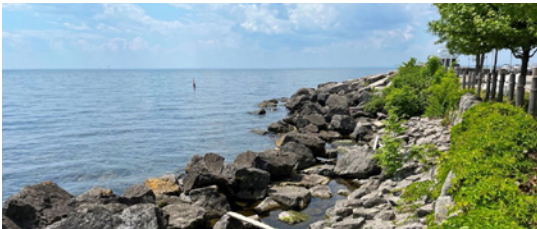

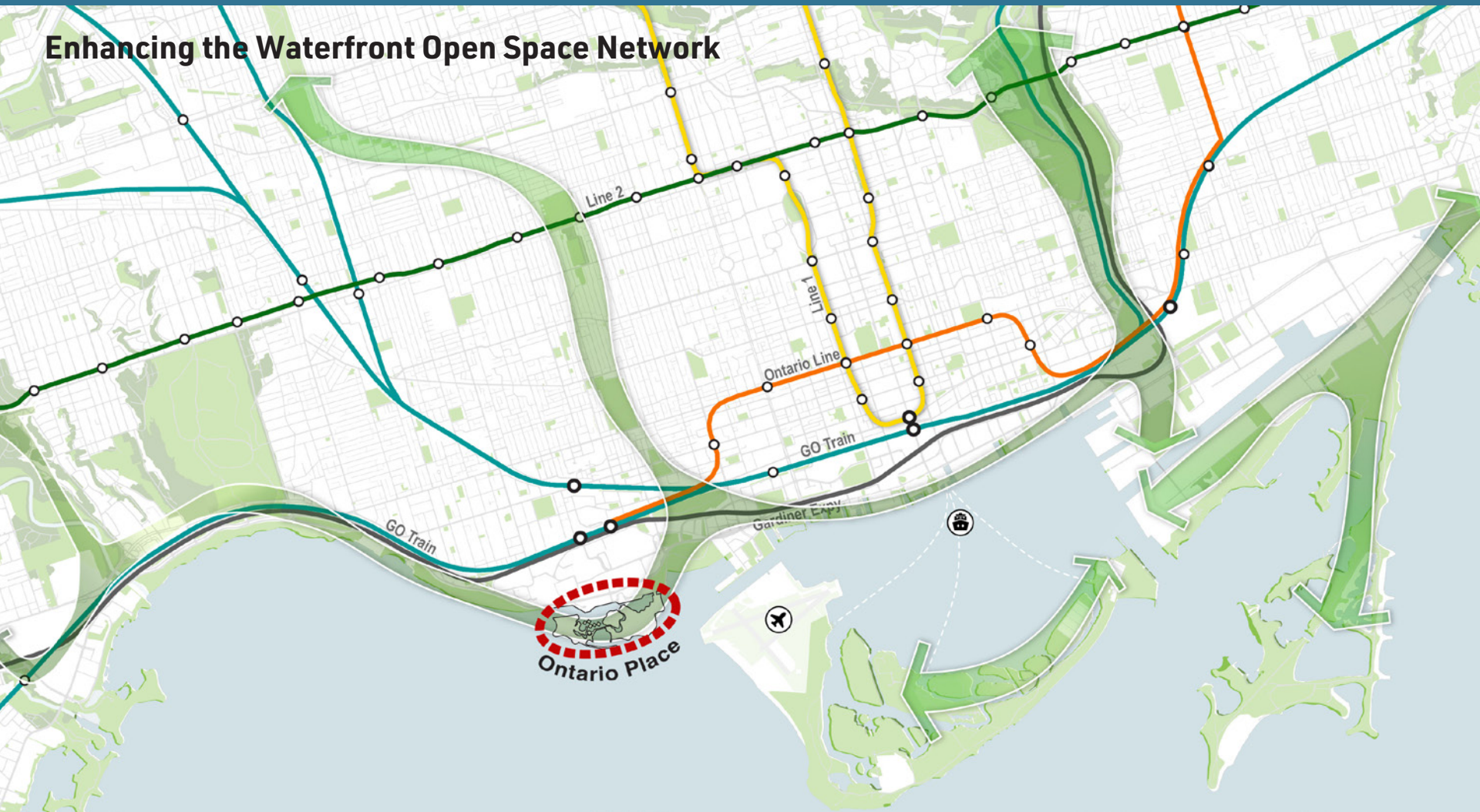

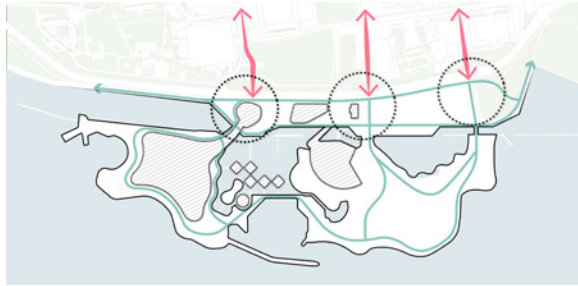
Ontario Place Revitalization Ambitions
