Re: Further Communication from the Grange Community Association (GCA) regarding agenda item TM 1.2

Further to the email communication from Ralph Daley, President, Grange Community Association (GCA) endorsing the slide-deck presentation entitled “How to Keep 100% of Osgoode Hall’s Green Space & Kickstart University Park” from Liz Driver and Steve Munro, the following additional comments are submitted.

1. The principles outlining in the communication (March 15th) regarding the functioning of the Liaison Committee submitted by the Lakeshore East Community Advisory Committee are endorsed. These principles pertain to meeting format, accountability, transparency, access and role of city officials.
2. The Osgoode Liaison Committee should be established immediately.
3. The recommendations outlined in the communication (March 20th) from Liz Driver, Campbell House are endorsed.
4. Parks Forestry and Recreation (PFR) should prepare a report on the standards for full restoration of the Osgoode Garden;
5. Campbell House and Osgoode Hall are essential heritage structures. Therefore, Metrolinx must disclose all reports on vibration monitoring.
6. Staff should increase the frequency of reporting beyond the semi-annual reports proposed in the March 8th, staff report.
