To the Chair and Members of the Sub-Committee on Metrolinx Ontario Line Construction

On behalf of the Grange Community Association, I write to endorse the slide-deck presentation entitled "How to Keep 100% of Osgoode Hall's Green Space & Kickstart University Park", to be presented to the TEYCC Sub-Committee on March 22.

This proposed modification of Metrolinx's current plan will have significant benefits for the public realm, while at the same time maintaining the keyhole and vertical circulation in the Osgoode Garden, which the Parsons Report found to be the most "workable design". This new idea is both reasonable and do-able, and should be considered for endorsement by the Sub-Committee.

We are also of the view that there should be reporting on a bi-monthly or quarterly basis, and that a Liaison Committee be established quickly for Osgoode Station.
