RECOMMENDATIONS

2) The Bid Award Panel grant authority to award Request for Tender Doc4066982785 to Duron Ontario LTD. for Disco Road Organics Processing Facility Tip Floor Rehabilitation for Solid Waste Management Services in accordance with the revised contract details set out in the report below:

The contract is expected to start on March 18, 2024 and end on June 17, 2026.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

The total contract award identified in this report is \$2,281,334 including all applicable taxes and charges. The total cost to the City is \$2,054,412 net of HST recoveries.

Funding is available in the 2024 Approved Capital Budget for Solid Waste Management Services. Additional funding details follow in Table 1.

The engineering estimate for this project is \$1,358,400 net of all taxes and charges.

- d. the Solicitation document was advertised on the City's internet website and bids or proposals were submitted electronically in Ariba; and
- e. the Fair Wage Office confirms the recommended firm understands the Fair Wage Policy and Labour Trades requirements and has agreed to comply fully.
