FINANCIAL IMPACT

The total contract award identified in this report is \$1,785,437 including all applicable taxes and charges. The total cost to the City is \$1,607,841 net of HST recoveries.

The engineering estimate for this project is \$960,360 net of all taxes and charges.

Funding is included in the 2024 Approved Capital Budget and 2025-2033 Approved Capital Plan for Transportation Services. Funding details are summarized in Table 1 below.
