FINANCIAL IMPACT

The total contract award identified in this report is \$4,967,597 including all applicable taxes and charges. The cost to the City is \$4,473,475 net of HST recoveries.

The engineering estimate for this project is \$4,175,876 net of all taxes and charges.

Funding is included in the 2024 Capital Budget and 2025-2033 Capital Plan for Transportation Services. Funding details are summarized as follows:
