\$12,874,085 net of all applicable taxes and charges

\$14,547,716 including HST and all applicable charges

\$13,100,669 net of HST recoveries

Contract is expected to start on date of award and end on December 31, 2025.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

The total contract award identified in this report is \$14,547,716 including all applicable taxes and charges. The cost to the City is \$13,100,669 net of HST recoveries.

The engineering estimate for this project is \$12,369,791 net of all taxes and charges.

Funding for this contract award is included in the 2024 Capital Budget and 2025-2033 Capital Plan for Toronto Water. Funding details are summarized in Table 1 as follows.
