### **Contract Award Value:**

\$3,121,428 net of all applicable taxes and charges \$3,527,213 including HST and all applicable charges \$3,176,365 net of HST recoveries

Contract is expected to start on November 4, 2024 and end on February 27, 2025.

### FINANCIAL IMPACT

The total contract award identified in this report is \$3,527,213 including all applicable taxes and charges. The cost to the City is \$3,176,365 net of HST recoveries.

The engineering estimate for this project is \$2,804,450 net of all taxes and charges.

Funding is included in the 2024 Capital Budget and 2025-2033 Capital Plan for Transportation Services. Funding details are summarized as follows:

- c. the total contract value is less than \$20 million dollars (excluding applicable taxes) and the contract term is:
  - 1. for a contract funded by the operating budget, 5 years or less including any option years; or
  - 2. for a contract funded by the capital budget, within the projected term of the capital funding for the project as set out in the capital budget,

being within the authority of the Bid Award Panel;

- d. the Solicitation document was advertised on the City's internet website and bids or proposals were submitted electronically in Ariba; and
- e. the Fair Wage Office confirms the recommended firm understands the Fair Wage Policy and Labour Trades requirements and has agreed to comply fully.
