After reviewing this Sourcewell Buying Group Document Number 113021-RVG-4, Toronto Fire Services is requesting to piggyback on this Sourcewell Buying Group Contract with Safetek Emergency Vehicles Ltd.

The contract is expected to start on the Date of Award and end on June 30, 2027.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

The total potential contract award identified in this report is \$6,717,023 including all applicable taxes and charges. The total potential cost to the City is \$6,048,887 net of HST recoveries.

Funding from the date of award is available in the 2024 Capital Budget and 2025-2033 Capital Plan for Fleet Services. Funding details follow in Table 1.
