2024 OPERATING BUDGET BRIEFING NOTE Toronto Poverty Reduction Strategy – Year by Year Budgeted Expenditures

Issue/Background:

- At its meeting on January 10, 2024, Budget Committee received a briefing note
 outlining the effort and new/enhanced investment made to support the <u>Toronto</u>
 <u>Poverty Reduction Strategy</u> included in the 2024 Staff Prepared Operating Budget.
- At its meeting on January 18, 2024, Budget Committee requested the Executive Director of Social Development, Finance and Administration to prepare a briefing note which outlines the year-by-year expenditure of the Poverty Reduction Strategy including new and enhanced programs for the previous 5 years. This briefing note responds to this request.
- Table 1 itemizes the New and Enhanced budget expenditures identified to advance poverty reduction goals since the adoption of the Strategy from 2015-2023 and the proposed amount for 2024.
- Each year, the City provides a Poverty Reduction Strategy Operating Budget Briefing Note at budget launch highlighting new and enhanced initiatives and associated investments to advance the Poverty Reduction Strategy. These notes identify proposed expenditures by program:
