## REASON FOR CONFIDENTIAL INFORMATION

This report deals with personal matters about identifiable individuals who are being considered for appointment to the Toronto Community Housing Corporation Board of Directors.

### **SUMMARY**

The Corporations Nominating Panel will conduct interviews and recommend one candidate to City Council for appointment to the Toronto Community Housing Corporation Board of Directors.

## RECOMMENDATIONS

The City Clerk recommends that:

- 1. The Corporations Nominating Panel recommend one public member to City Council for appointment to the Toronto Community Housing Corporation Board of Directors, at pleasure of Council, for a term of office ending June 16, 2025, and until a successor is appointed.
- 2. City Council direct that Confidential Attachments 1a, 1b, and 2 to 4 remain confidential in their entirety as they relate to personal matters about identifiable individuals being considered for appointment to the Toronto Community Housing Corporation Board of Directors.

## **Composition of the Toronto Community Housing Corporation Board**

The board has a total of 13 members including:

- the Mayor or the Mayor's designate
- 2 City Councillors
- 3 tenant directors
- 7 public members

## There is currently one position under consideration

There is currently one position under consideration due to the resignation of one public member on April 22, 2024.

## Term of appointment is until June 16, 2025

The term of office for public members of City corporations is two years. The member appointed through this process will serve a term ending on June 16, 2025, and until a successor is appointed. This term is less than two years in order to coincide with the term end date of other members appointed to the board.

## **Board members must meet certain qualifications**

In addition to the general eligibility requirements in the Public Appointments Policy, board members should collectively represent a range of expertise including:

- knowledge of the field of social housing
- housing advocacy or community development
- land development
- property management
- business management
- corporate governance
- organizational development
- labour relations
- business law
- social services for hard-to-serve tenants

#### **Board members receive remuneration**

- The Chair receives a \$20,000 annual retainer.
- Public members receive a \$2,500 annual retainer, plus \$500 per meeting up to an annual maximum of \$10,000.

#### Public release of the name of the recommended candidate

The name and biography of the recommended candidate will be publicly reported once the Corporations Nominating Panel forwards its recommendations to City Council.
