As the operator of RioCan Marketplace, a shopping plaza located at the southwest corner of Steeles Ave West and Dufferin St., we are writing in support of accelerating improved bus service on Steeles Ave as part of RapidTO.

The current state of traffic on Steeles Ave is a deterrent for potential customers. The congestion not only causes delays, but frustration that dissuades people from visiting the area, impacting the foot traffic and, consequently, the business of our tenants. The introduction of bus priority measures would help to alleviate these issues by streamlining public transport flow and reducing overall traffic on the roadway. These improvements would make our plaza more accessible and encourage more customers to visit, thus benefiting all businesses within our premises.
