12 Communications were received with text similar to the following:

I am writing in support of IE13.4 to fairly expand car share access to everyone across our city, and I ask that City Council support this expansion as well. Current rules for car share are unfairly stopping residents in Scarborough, North York, and Etobicoke from having access to car share services. I would benefit from being able to occasionally access a car without having to pay upwards of \$10,000 per year to own and operate a personal vehicle. This city has become too unaffordable for people and too congested for everyone to be driving all the time. As noted in the City staff report, car share goes hand in hand with increased walking, cycling, and transit use, while reducing the number of cars owned in the city and the amount of driving that residents do. Expanding the car share program citywide is a great step forward to a more affordable city, with less congestion, healthier residents, and a city that is fairer and more sustainable. Please vote in favour of IE13.4 to expand car share citywide and allow more people to live car-lite lives.
