








 <p>Bicycles/tricycles and *electric powered bicycles/tricycles that require some muscular power</p>	✓	✓	✓	✓ (*E-bike weighing less than 40kg & requires some muscular power)	✗ (13 year old or under can bicycle on a sidewalk)
 <p>Cargo/e cargo bike/tricycle (with a container in back or front) that requires some muscular power (max 120kg unladen)</p>	✓	✓	✓	✗	✗
<p>Throttle, electric motor-scooter that requires no pedalling and no muscular power. Max 32km/h speed capability.</p> 	✓	✓	✗	✗	✗
<p>Low-speed vehicle (e mini-car) must meet federal standards, have licence plate, be insured and registered through Service Ontario. Max 40km/h speed capability. Requires driver's licence to operate.</p> 	✓	✗	✗	✗	✗
<p>Capable of speeds greater than 32km/h</p>  <p>Moped (motor scooter) Motorcycle</p>	✓	✗	✗	✗	✗
