This is a comment for the December 17, 2024 City Council meeting on item 2024.TE18.9, Designation of the Teiaiagon-Baby Point Heritage Conservation District under Part V of the Ontario Heritage Act.

On December 16, 2024, Six Nations of the Grand River (SNGR) Elected Council voted to support the city's proposed Teiaiagon-Baby Point Historical Conservation District Plan.

Teiaiagon is very important to SNGR members and former Chief Ava Hill wrote a January 13, 2017 letter supporting the creation of a Historical Conservation District (HCD) and emphasizing the need to protect archaeological resources.

Subsequently, SNGR's Consultation and Accommodation Process (CAP) Team worked closely with city staff to ensure Haudenosaunee heritage was acknowledge and preserved.

The creation of the Teiaiagon-Baby Point HCD Plan is a positive step in our relationship with Toronto. We look forward to collaborating with the city on future projects.
