Re: Ex 19.6 – Assessment of Scarborough Rapid Transit Adaptive Reuse and Next Steps

It has come to our attention that statements were made at the recent Executive Committee meeting of December 10, 2024, indicating Oxford Properties' support for the ongoing studies related to the repurposing of the existing elevated SRT rail corridor, a portion of which encumbers our lands at Scarborough Town Centre.

We understand that this item will be considered by City Council on December 17, 2024.

This will confirm that those statements do not reflect Oxford's position. We are supportive of the recommendation to substantially remove the SRT infrastructure no longer required for transit operations so the corridor lands may be considered for future uses.
